Sub: Guidelines for Implementation of Soft Skills Training in 62 Government Arts & Science College – Reg.

As per G.O. (Ms) No.5 Dt.19-01-2013 and G.O. (Ms) No.111 Dt.9-5-2016 TANSCHER has been conducting this programme in 62 Government Colleges. Funds for Soft Skills training is being released for the 62 Government Arts & Science Colleges. The following guidelines may be used for the implementation of Soft Skills training for 500 III year UG students of the College from the recurring grant of Rs 2.50 lakhs:

- This programme is to be conducted without affecting the college working hours particularly it should be conducted only after college hours.
- A trained faculty member may be appointed as Coordinator for the Soft Skills programme. A sum of Rs.3000/- may be paid as honorarium to the Coordinator.
- A sum of Rs.17,000/- may be set aside from the 2.50 lakh for purchase of toner, stationery, and other overhead charges and Rs.5,000/- may be paid to administrative expenses.
- 500 students from III year UG programme may be selected for Soft Skills training.
- Soft Skills training in Communication Skills, Personality Development, Presentation Skills, Language skills, CV/Resume writing and facing interviews may be conducted.
- Trainers may be identified from within the college, Corporates / soft skill trainers outside the college may be engaged as resource persons to impart training to students.
- An amount of **Rs. 450/-** (one hour) may be paid as honorarium to the trainers per session. Rs.450 per session x 500 students ($450 \times 500 = 2,25,000$). The training may be completed before 31st March 2023.
- The attendance of the student participants and that of the Soft Skills trainers (within college and from corporates) may be submitted in the attached format along with original vouchers, receipts, and Utilisation Certificate to reach Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education on or before 15th April 2023 without fail.



Sub: Guidelines for Implementation of Soft Skills Training in 62 Government Arts & Science College – Reg.

As per G.O. (Ms) No.5 Dt.19-01-2013 and G.O. (Ms) No.111 Dt.9-5-2016 TANSICHE has been conducting this programme in 62 Government Colleges. As Colleges have started functioning post COVID-19 in the regular mode, funds for Soft Skills training is being released for the 62 Government Arts & Science Colleges. The following guidelines may be used for the implementation of Soft Skills training for 500 III year UG students of the College from the recurring grant of Rs 2.50 lakhs:

- This programme is to be conducted without affecting the college working hours particularly it should be conducted only after college hours.
- A trained faculty member may be appointed as Coordinator for the Soft Skills programme. A sum of Rs.3000/- may be paid as honorarium to the Coordinator.
- A sum of Rs.17,000/- may be set aside from the 2.50 lakh for purchase of toner, stationery, and other overhead charges and Rs.5,000/- may be paid to administrative expenses.
- 500 students from III year UG programme may be selected for Soft Skills training. If needed II year UG students may be included in the training programme.
- Soft Skills training in Communication Skills, Personality Development, Presentation Skills, Language skills, CV/Resume writing and facing interviews may be conducted.
- Trainers may be identified from within the college, Corporates / soft skill trainers outside the college may be engaged as resource persons to impart training to students.
- An amount of **Rs. 400/-** (one hour) may be paid as honorarium to the trainers per session. 400 sessions x 500 students (**400 x 500 = 2,00,000**) may be conducted in April, May, June, July 2022. The training may be completed before 31.07.2022.
- The attendance of the student participants and that of the Soft Skills trainers (within college and from corporates) may be submitted in the attached format along with original vouchers, receipts, and Utilisation Certificate to reach Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education on or before 07.08.2022 without fail.

The meeting of the Principals and Coordinators of 32 Government Arts and Science Colleges where the Soft Skills programme has been implemented as second phase was conducted on 15 September 2016 in TANSCHÉ Conference room at 10:30 am.

The following points were discussed and finalized. It was unanimously agreed that the decisions taken in the meeting are binding on Principals and Coordinators including those who failed to attend the meeting. Principals who have deputed senior faculty on their behalf and Principals-in-charge are also bound by the decisions taken in the meeting. The minutes may be handed over to the administrative heads.

- Soft Skills classes should commence before 10th October 2016.
- Soft Skills classes to be conducted continuously till 31 March 2017 and all reports to be submitted by 5 April 2017 without fail.
- Only teachers trained for Soft Skills to be engaged in training students. Involving all the teachers in the institution to exhaust and distribute the funds is not permissible.
- List to trained Soft Skills teachers available in the institution to be furnished to TANSCHÉ immediately to reach us on or before 7th October 2016 along with separate Soft Skills email ID.
- Clarification was sought regarding remuneration to be given to the Soft Skills Coordinator of the college as the work of organization, monitoring and preparation of reports places more demands on the coordinator
- Representatives of some colleges stated that due to lack of infrastructure, the regular college itself functions in 2 shifts and that conducting Soft Skills classes after college hours is not possible. These colleges were advised to utilize halls/rooms which did not function as classrooms.
- The representatives of the college also requested for a syllabus/teaching modules to be provided by TANSCHÉ so that the colleges could devise their curriculum for the soft skill classes To
