- (ii) IQA and SSR Preparation for the II cycle.



A frank discussion was held among the IQAC and the HOD's and various unit heads. ~~various~~ ~~help~~







It was resolved to verify all the problems and the HOD's assured to provide the data of their departments to the IQAC in time.

It was resolved to insist the departments without postgraduation to send proposals to introduce PG programmes.





